We take responsibility to mentor and support school and college students who cannot afford online education during the pandemic. We have college students from established colleges throughout the country mentoring school students, and working professionals from around the world mentoring college students. The mentoring happens through one-to-one scheduled phone calls for a time period of 30 days for school students and 15 days for college students. Over 600+ school students and 300+ college students are mentored across Tamil Nadu and Karnataka.
