

A SHORT STORY ABOUT IT

Students are the pillars of our society. We won't be able to draw out their true potential unless we guide, support, and direct them. With this in mind, during the pandemic, we began a project called Express phone mentoring for school students.

We connected government school students from rural parts of Tamil Nadu and Karnataka whose families cannot afford online education in the wake of the global pandemic, with college students across the country. We were successful in creating a holistic platform where the school students got to learn English speaking and writing through fun activities and regular interaction. College students from 120+ colleges mentored 630+ students on a one-on-one basis during the same.

KANAA DIY SESSION






TALK TUCKER




TQI ZHAGARAM
